Objectives

The final objective is to increase the number and the quality of cross-sectorial transnational innovation projects

Description

The project addresses the lack of operational, customized tools aimed at overcoming the problems of cooperation between clusters. It will be characterized by a:

- Territorially-driven approach to strengthen the value chains, focusing on S3 priorities
- Bottom-up approach, moving from the intermediary players (cluster managers)

In order to consolidate a process of **cross-sectorial fertilization**, it will be organized according to two parallel approaches.

First, the project will target the emergence of collaborative, cross-cluster projects with a focus on the **process leading to the emergence of innovative inter-cluster ideas** and their formalization.

Second, inter-cluster collaboration will be actively implemented amongst **mature cluster projects** through **pilot demonstrators**.

This approach may be developed in one of two ways:

- Support for selected project ideas (emerging from clusters)
- Implementation of high-level projects proposed to selected SMEs within clusters based on their technological expertise
